



Year 12 Music Scholarships

Year 12 music scholarships are intended to identify and develop impressive musical talent in the Sixth Form, in preparation for further study at university or other higher education institutions. Students are invited to audition in their first half term at Graveney and those who are successful will be notified before October half term.

Applicants will be asked to perform two pieces on their first instrument or voice, respond to aural tests and complete a theory paper. This will be followed by a short informal interview. Applicants may also choose to perform on a second instrument.

We recommend that applicants are grade 7 standard or above when they apply, however, we welcome applications from students who may not currently have graded exam certificates, as we are looking for musical potential as much as prior experience.

As a music scholar you would receive:

- 100% subsidy on fees for your first study instrument or voice throughout Sixth Form
- Priority invitations to attend external concerts and events
- Priority invitations to attend workshops with professional musicians
- Opportunities to lead and develop musical ensembles
- Opportunities to perform in formal and informal concerts

As a music scholar, you would be expected to:

- Study Music A Level
- Become a music prefect, working in the department for at least 1 hour per week
- Participate in a variety of instrumental and choral ensembles
- Participate in music events in and out of school
- Regularly perform in chamber concerts
